- Represent AOCMF R&D within the AOCMF International Board (ex officio voting member; 3-4 meetings per year)
- Represent AOCMF R&D at AOCMF International Retreats (every third year / 3 days)
- Represent AOCMF R&D within the AO Foundation's R&D Platform (ex officio voting member, 1 meeting per year)
- Coordinate all AOCMF R&D activities
- Advise the AOCMF International Board on matters related to research and development
- Support AOCMF R&D budget planning (within framework defined by AOCMF International Board)
- Submit AOCMF R&D budget to AOCMF International Board for approval
- Function as point of contact on R&D related issues for AOCMF community members
- Supervise and monitor AOCMF R&D projects (milestones and budget)
- Cooperation with the AO Research Review Commission for submitted project proposals
- Ensure fruitful collaboration with the AO Research Institute and AO Clinical Investigation and Documentation Department
- Comply to the AOF Shared values and the Code of Ethics
