- Must be a resident in the Central Africa subregion
- Must be highly motivated to contribute to build and maintain educational programs
- Must have national and regional networks and strong interpersonal skills
- Must be able and willing to work in a comprehensive, constructive and inclusive
 way with surgeons of different surgical backgrounds, including but not limited to
 oral and maxillofacial surgeons, plastic surgeons, otolaryngologists, head and neck
 surgeons, ophthalmic and oculoplastic surgeons, and neurosurgeons
- Must be willing and prepared to travel regionally (no exclusions)
- Must be a good/clear communicator, good listener, possess the ability to work in multi-cultural environments



- · Must have good command of the English language
- Must be prepared to commit adequate time (eg, one day per month) to AOCMF/ AO Foundation affairs
