Requirements General

- Must be a current AOCMF member, preferably holding a position at a university or academic institution
- Must be an active AOCMF ESA faculty member with educational experience within the last five years from the Britannia subregion
- Must be a resident in the Britannia subregion
- Must be highly motivated to build and maintain educational programs
- Must have national and regional networks and strong interpersonal skills
- Must be able and willing to work in a comprehensive, constructive and inclusive way with surgeons of different surgical backgrounds, including but not limited to oral and maxillofacial surgeons, plastic surgeons, otolaryngologists, head and neck surgeons, ophthalmic and oculoplastic surgeons, and neurosurgeons
- Must be willing and prepared to travel regionally (no exclusions)
- Must be a good communicator and listener with the ability to work in multicultural environments
- Must possess a good command of the English language
- Must be prepared to commit adequate time (eg, one day per month) to AOCMF/AO Foundation affairs

In addition, she/he:

- Should have international experience (eg, fellowship, faculty, or research travel)
- Should be a recognized member or officer on key national, regional, or international CMF associations
- Should be recognized as excellent educator
- Should have relevant research experience
- Should have a good scientific reputation regionally, supported by high-quality academic publications, books, etc.
